


A Mirrored Text Effect can be achieved via WordArt or via a Text Box... (Applies to MS Word 2010 and 2013 Versions)

### WORDART

1. From the INSERT tab – WordArt icon – select the first one (it's the 'plainest') – key in the text you want to replace the default of "Your text here"
2. Use the HOME tab to re-size the text and select the font required
3. Use the DRAWING TOOLS/ Format tab - to get the text looking how you want it
4. From the DRAWING TOOLS/ Format – select TEXT EFFECTS/ 3-D ROTATION/ 3-D ROTATION OPTIONS...
5. From the dialogue box – key in 180 for 'X' axis rotation – then click on Close
6. Done.




### TEXT BOX

1. From the INSERT Tab – insert a Text Box – do the usual to enter your text and format font, size etc. as necessary
2. Use the same technique as above to rotate 'X' by 180 degrees.

**Method also works with a SHAPE**

1. INSERT tab – SHAPES – select your shape, - then 'click and drag' to size your required shape, and just start typing to add your text
2. Do the usual formatting for font, size etc.
3. Use the same technique as described above to rotate 'X' by 180 degrees.
